- Describe how to locate the placenta and identify previa.
- Indicate the policies, procedures, and protocols necessary to provide safe and excellent patient care.
- Evaluate the patient's response to ultrasound findings and implement appropriate intervention based upon that response.
- Discuss appropriate assessment, communication and education regarding the ultrasound procedure, its purpose, limitations, and findings.

- Describe the basic principles of ultrasound physics in creating an image, and how to assure safe practices.
- Identify landmarks required to document an intrauterine pregnancy, estimate the gestational age and confirm a heartbeat.
- List important medical needs of the PMC patient.
- Critique ultrasound images to determine adequate documentation of intrauterine pregnancy, estimated gestational age and cardiac activity.
- Participate in cross sectional lab exercises, and practice scanning, utilizing specific knobology.
